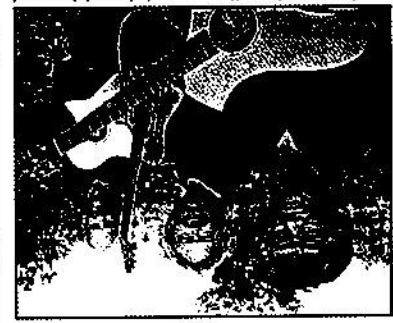
SONS OF SERENDIP
